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Background

Dr. Charlie Kohl is a manager specializing in intellectual property litigation at Elysium Digital. Charlie's work has included an expert report on misappropriation of trade secrets; infringement analysis of software products in the iOS, Android, Linux, and Windows operating systems; damages analysis; design of workarounds for potential infringement; and forensic analysis and reporting. Charlie's doctoral research involved rule-based systems for the interpretation of natural images.

Prior to joining Elysium Digital, Dr. Kohl managed software development efforts as CTO, Chief Architect, and Vice President of Engineering at a number of early and mid-stage companies. At Open Learning Exchange, he developed open-source software for the creation and sharing of global K-12 educational materials.
